1. The validity of the permission will be within 6 months from the date of the issuance of this letter.
2. Upon arrival of the above said commodity at the custom point, the food or custom inspection authority can draw samples from the lot of the consignment arrived. The lot approaching at the custom port should be verified according to the detail of description as mentioned at the time of application. Any alteration in quality, quantity than mentioned in application detail is considered a violation of Food Act and Regulation.
3. In case of some incidence occurred at and around the territory of export or during the time of goods in transit affecting plant, animal and human life and if its implication to the imported product is considered risk prone and detrimental to the plant, animal and human life of destination territory then the import permission issued can be immediately withdrawn without prior notice. In such circumstance the sole liability of the losses arise because of such accidental and disaster factors goes to the importing firm itself. However, this will not contradict with the process of insurance claim on behalf of the importing firm.
4. This permission of import is effectively within the domain of Food Act and Regulation and SPS regime. It is the importer's responsibility to respond other concerning Act and Regulation of Nepal whenever necessary.
